COMPLETION OF SHARE PURCHASE PLAN

RungePincockMinarco Limited (ASX: RUL) (the *Company*) is pleased to announce that it has issued 1,473,482 new shares as a result of the Company's Share Purchase Plan. These shares were issued at the same price as the recent Institutional Share Placement (55 cents) resulting in approximately AUD \$810,415 being raised.

The Share Purchase Plan (SPP) was limited to Australian and New Zealand residents who were shareholders in the Company as at 7:00pm (Sydney time) on 4 April 2013 and provided those eligible shareholders the ability to acquire between \$2,000 and \$15,000 worth of shares in the Company at the same price at which they were issued under the Company's recent institutional placement, which was a two cent discount to the closing price on 2 April 2013 (the last trading day before the Company announced the placement).

All of the Company's Directors participated to the full extent of their entitlement and a high percentage of the remaining applications were subscribed from the Company's employee base.

As announced on 5 April 2013 the SPP was capped at a maximum of 2 million shares and the Company will issue 1,473,482 new Shares as a result of the SPP and all eligible holders who submitted applications under the SPP have had their application accepted in full.

Commenting on the SPP, Richard Mathews, CEO of the Company said "We are delighted with the level of support which we have received from our retail investor base. All of the funds which have been raised from our retail investors will be used to accelerate our enterprise software development".
