Introduction

Underground coal mining overview, performance & technology, regional overview, and asset value process.

Geology & Exploration

Coal geology, coal types & properties, exploration (process, methods & costs), modelling, considerations for design, and reporting.

Mining Systems

Bord & pillar (room & pillar), longwall, alternative systems, equipment, and cost estimation.

Mine Planning

Strategic planning process, concept planning, feasibility process, mine layout, equipment scheduling, and margin ranking.

Geotechnical

Assessments, ground support design (development & production), inputs into mine design, factors impacting mine operability, and multi-seam longwalls.

Ventilation & Gas

Reservoirs, managing uncertainty, planning, drainage, and economics.

Engineering & Short Term Planning

Mine access, equipment requirements, clearance systems, equipment selection, mining services, and production & maintenance planning.

Health & Safety

Hazards & risks, statistics, managing risk, incident case study, and incident investigations.

Financial Assessments

Cost and revenue drivers, capital requirements, financial tools, and decision making.

Overview

This course provides those from a non-mining background with a comprehensive understanding of underground coal mining. The course details both technical and operational aspects of an underground operation. The course pays particular attention to the planning processes and provides attendees with a clear insight into the business drivers for underground coal mines.
